IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN

Just a reminder that January is the start of the CCNA calendar year and your 2013 dues were due January 1st.

Remember a portion of your dues is for snow removal. For only \$1.25 per month, our streets will be plowed when it snows three inches or more. (The city **only** plows when it snows six inches at one time and then our neighborhood would not be given preferential treatment over any other neighborhood.)

For your convenience, you may pay your dues by check, cash or PayPal (that option is on our website at [CCNA PayPal](#)).

If you're paying by check or cash, be sure to complete the Dues Coupon provided in this newsletter. **PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: CCNA** and mail or drop your payment off to our Treasurer, Terri Atkinson.

Note: If using the PayPal option and you normally pay \$15 per year (interior streets), there is a PayPal charge of 75 cents so the total paid will be \$15.75. If you normally pay \$5 (College, 91st, & 96th Streets), the PayPal charge is 45 cents for a total of \$5.45. There is also a PayPal option for those residents who would like to pay more than the above amounts.

Last year, only 31% of households paid their dues. CCNA spent \$485 more than we received in expenses with the bulk going to snow removal \$1395.00. And now that our snow removal private contractor/resident has moved from our local area, we can expect a substantial increase in the cost of snow removal in the future.
