CCNA ANNUAL MEETING & CRIME WATCH PRESENTATION

The CCNA annual board meeting and election will follow a crime watch presentation by Jennifer Jones of the Marion County Prosecutor's Office. Jennifer is a member of the Multi-Jurisdictional Offender Strategy Team. She will relay helpful information for securing your property.

ELECTION - November is the next election of our association board of directors. As a dues-paying resident, you may nominate yourself or someone else for a position. Deadline is November 5. Contact the nominating committee chair, Tim Jones, 317-640-0727. He will verify the nominee's willingness to be elected before putting the person's name on the slate.

Without any new nominations, the slate of officers to be voted on for 2014 will remain the same as those shown on the list of current CCNA Board of Directors at the end of this newsletter.

WHAT CCNA DOES FOR YOU

Your CCNA Board members oversee the care and best interest of our neighborhood.

- We attend government and civic meetings to stay abreast on matters that affect our neighborhood.
- We respond to phone calls from concerned residents and work with the Mayor's Action Center and the appropriate government department to address their concerns.

- Our Crime Watch Coordinator and Street Representatives make sure residents are aware of any criminal activity in our neighborhood via phone calls or emails.
- The Board contracts with a snow plowing service to maintain our streets when it snows less than the six-inch street department standard for plowing.

Whether it is helping a resident deal with a code compliance issue or alerting police about homes where criminal activities are ongoing,

we work very hard to keep our neighborhood "an uncommonly nice place to live".

CRIME WATCH PROCEDURES

When reporting criminal activity, **ALL** neighbors can be reached within 45 minutes by making two calls:

1. Call 911 (non-emergency, 327-3811)
2. Call Crime Watch Coordinator Daniel Harrison @ 812-219-5033

The flow is: CCNA Crime Watch Coordinator to CCNA Officers to CCNA Street Representatives to CCNA Captains/ Watchers who then contact adjacent neighbors.....all happening within 45 minutes.

2014 CCNA DUES

January 1, 2014 is the start of the CCNA fiscal year and 2014 dues are due at that time.

Remember a portion of your dues is for snow removal. For only \$1.25 a month, you will be able to make it to your job, doctor visits, etc. this winter since your street will be plowed. Without the dues from **ALL**, the risk exists we won't have the funds for snow removal. (For fiscal year 2013, only 54% of CCNA households paid their dues.)

For your convenience, you may pay your dues by check, cash or PayPal.

If you're paying by check or cash, be sure to complete and follow the instructions on the 2014 CCNA Dues Coupon provided in this newsletter.

If you wish to pay via PayPal, access the CCNA web site at collegecommons.org and go to Neighborhood News, Association Dues, Pay Dues Through PayPal, or if you are reading this newsletter electronically, just press

Note: If using the PayPal option and you normally pay \$15 per year (interior streets), there is a PayPal charge of 75 cents so the total paid will be \$15.75. If you normally pay \$5 (College, 91st, & 96th Streets), the PayPal charge is 45 cents for a total of \$5.45. There is also a PayPal option for those residents who would like to pay more than the above amounts.
